Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our Walk on the Wildside topic, we have organised a visit to the National Trust's Leigh Woods on Tuesday 18th July. We will be leaving school at 9.15am and returning for 3.20 collection.

This visit will give the children the opportunity to investigate which animals and plants live in this habitat and what they need to survive. The children will be participating in the Living Things workshops led by the National Trust discovering what a diverse habitat the woods are.

The children will be spending the day outside so will need to dress appropriately for the activities and the British weather.

On the day, the children will need to wear comfortable walking shoes, long trousers and a school t-shirt/ jumper. Additionally, a waterproof coat or a sunhat may be required depending on the weather.

We can provide a packed lunch if you would like one, or you are welcome to provide your own if you prefer. All children will also need to bring a plastic water bottle.

This trip has been partly funded by the school's purchase of a National Trust membership. In order to meet the full costs of the workshops and the coach, we would need a contribution of £10.50 per child. The trip has been set up on ParentPay where you can also request a free school meal if you would like one. Once you have made a contribution and/or requested a packed lunch, this is treated as permission for your child to attend the trip so there is no need for a paper permission slip. You will need to do this in order to give permission for your child to attend the trip.

If the funds raised are insufficient then the trip will have to be cancelled. If you are registered for Pupil Premium and would like help with the payments, please see Ms Fredrickson.
