



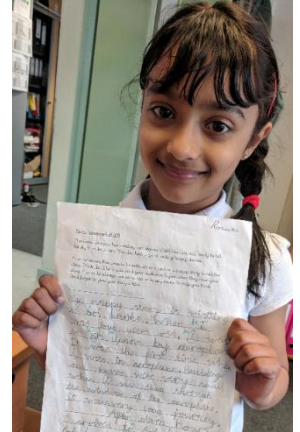
Congratulations to the following children who have impressed me with their wonderful work and attitudes so far this term:

- Lexie in Y4 for a brilliant story about demon dinner ladies!

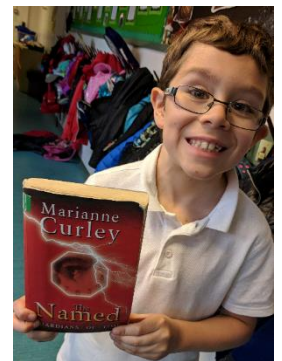
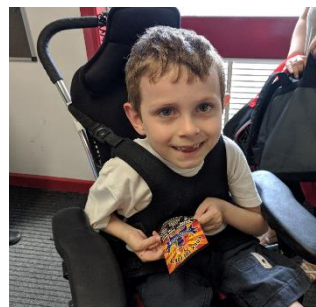

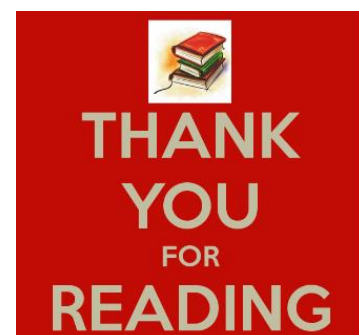
Coronation Cup
