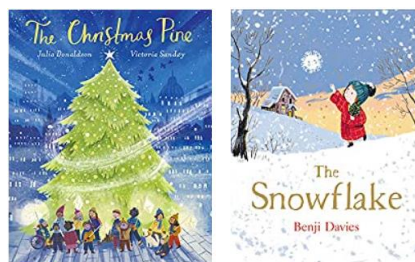

Top Tips For Developing Prediction At Home

EYFS

Predicting means using the clues given by the author and our own experiences to make a good guess about what might happen next.

Spend time at home reading a few pages of a book (we recommend using your library book for this). Use the front cover to suggest which character might be in the text and where it might be set.

Phase 1

Using your child's library book, use the sentence starter 'I think that' or 'I predict that' to make a suggestion about the events that may happen next in the text.

Ask your child to explain the reason for their prediction using clues given by the author or their own knowledge and experiences.

Phase 2

Using your child's library book, use the sentence starter 'I predict that' to make a feasible suggest about how a character may act or feel.

Ask your child to justify their prediction using evidence from the text. For example, has the author used any particular words or phrases to support their prediction?
